**Sub: Declaration of Country Freedom from Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (H5N1)**


Sir / Madam,

The outbreaks of Avian Influenza (HPAI) at various epicenters, in Odisha [Budhibara (Sanasahi) & Patharaganja, Malud, Brahmandeo, Kanheipur (Harijansahi), Epinga (Bauripalli), Nandala, Naba, Kantabania & Nuagoan, Udaygiri, Government Duck Breeding Farm, Khapurja], Bihar (Goraho, Mubarakchak, and Babura) and Jharkhand (Fazil Khuthari), in the country were notified to OIE and control and containment operations were carried out as per the guidelines of the extant Action Plan on Preparedness, Control and Containment of Avian Influenza. The control measures adopted in the radii of one km around the outbreak locations included -

- i. stamping out of entire poultry population including destruction of eggs, feed, litter and other infected materials,
- ii. restriction on movement of poultry and poultry products to and from the areas of outbreak,
- iii. disinfection and cleaning up of infected premises and;
- iv. the Post Operation Surveillance Plan (POSP)

3. It is pertinent to note that following the completion of the operation (including culling, disinfection and clean-up) at the above epicenters, there have been no further reports of the presence of HPAI virus. Accordingly, the country is declared free from Avian Influenza ( H5N1) w e.f. 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2019 which has already been notified to OIE.

4. It is, however, emphasized that the surveillance will shall have to continue throughout the country, especially in the vulnerable bordering areas from where possibility of ingress of infection exists and in areas frequented by migratory birds. Finally, it is reiterated that states should not be complacent due to the declaration of country freedom from Avian Influenza but must maintain strict vigil against the disease.
