ORDER

Subject: Appeal under RTI Act, 2005 received from Shri. B.P. Nagar.

This appeal dated 03-12-2018 has been filed by the Appellant Shri B.P. Nagar, stating that CPIO has failed to provide complete information in response his RTI application dt. 01.10.18. He alleged that incorrect information has been provided to him and requested that correct and complete information may be provided to him.

2. On prima facie scrutiny of the issue reveals that the RTI Act, 2005 stipulates as under:


“Information shall ordinarily be provided in the form in which it is sought unless it would disproportionately divert the resources of the public authority or would be detrimental to the safety or preservation of the record in question;

Further information which relates to personal information the disclosure of which has no relationship to any public activity or interest, or which would cause unwarranted invasion of the privacy of the individual unless the Central Public Information Officer or the State Public Information Officer or the appellate authority, as the case may be, is satisfied that the larger public interest justifies the disclosure of such information”

3. As per section 2(f) of the RTI Act, 2005 “information” means any material in any form, including records, documents, memos, e-mails, opinions, advices, press releases, circulars, orders, logbooks, contracts, reports, papers, samples, models, data material held in any electronic form and information relating to any private body which can be accessed by a public authority under any other law for the time being in force;

4. Having gone through the records and fact of the case, I observed that CPIO has already provided all requisite information in response to application of the appellant. It has been noted that the applicant was advised to deposit necessary fee for providing copies of relevant documents which has not yet been remitted by him. Further I find that most of the information sought against Sl. No.1 to 6 is related to his own service matters, in the form of query and is supposed to be already available with the applicant. However, having regard to the provisions of RTI Act, I give an opportunity to Shri B.P. Nagar to inspect the relevant files and obtain copies of relevant documents as per his requirement within 30 days of receipt of this Order.

This appeal stands disposed.
